Pastoral Areas: Bishop Farrell has formed 13 Pastoral Areas, and grouped Thomastown and Inistioge together, so the two parishes are asked to foster collaboration in the years ahead. Reps from the two Parish Pastoral Councils will meet on Thursday to identify priorities and to address the number of Masses in the Area, with a view to allowing a maximum choice for parishioners to attend Mass in their own Parish. The schedule must also allow a reduced number of priests to cover Masses in neighbouring parishes. The Bishop proposes that the decision about reducing and rescheduling Masses should be finalised before the end of June. The new schedule of Masses is to be introduced across the Diocese on the First Sunday of Advent 2019.

Notification of changes to chaplaincy list protocol at St. Luke's Hospital in Kilkenny: The General Services Manager has informed Bishop Farrell that with the introduction of GDPR legislation, the Hospital will no longer be providing a chaplaincy list on request by a priest. If a patient of the Hospital requests a visit from a priest, they should contact the priest directly. If a priest would like to know the ward location of a patient, they can enquire at the hospital reception desk.
