## COVID - 19 Steps we are taking

To help counter the spread of infection, we are asked to:

- suspend shaking hands at Mass as a sign of peace;
- suspend the distribution of the chalice (including for concelebrants);
- receive Holy Communion only on the hand;
- suspend the use of holy water fonts;
- request Eucharistic Ministers and Priest to use hand sanitiser before and after distributing Holy Communion;
- Collection baskets: priests are asked to provide an alternative to the practice of passing
  collection baskets through the congregation. For example, parishioners may place your
  envelope donation in a supervised basket box at the entrance to the church as they enter or
  exit, or both in the case where two collections are taken up.
- use the hand sanitiser placed at the Church doors.
- use normal sensible procedure when sneezing etc.
- If you are unwell please, as a precaution, stay at home and you can follow Mass on TV, by local radio and from some parishes on our Diocesan website.

For now, while the holy water fonts are not being used, if anyone would like to have holy water blessed for use in their own home, the Priest celebrating Mass is happy to do so after Mass.
