All parishioners will join in the Parish Church for Holy Week, Easter Sunday and Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses. It was decided too that from Advent Funeral Masses won't be held in the Area on Sundays. Please God we will all approach and embrace this new time with openness, courage and hope.
