The Diocesan Synodal group are working away to ready themselves and in time our parishes, for the synodal process. We will have three phases in this process in Ossory.

First Phase (February – March) In these months we will create awareness of Synod/synodality throughout the Diocese.

Second Phase Lent (March, April) During our "Listening Lent" we will have consultation sessions in all our parishes and Pastoral Areas to ensure that the voices of all in Ossory are heard.

Third Phase (April, May) During Easter the Synod Group will collate all these responses (what has been heard) to share with the bishop and each other.
