This is also true from a spiritual standpoint: we ought to cultivate our interior life through the reading of the word of God, daily prayer, reception of the sacraments and participation in the liturgy. We should also cultivate our relationships with others: first of all, by showing affectionate concern for our families, our children and grandchildren, but also for the poor and those who suffer, by drawing near to them with practical assistance and our prayers. These things will help us not to feel like mere bystanders, sitting on our porches or looking out from our windows, as life goes on all around us. Instead, we should learn to discern everywhere the presence of the Lord. We can become a blessing for those who live next to us.
