Pastoral Area: Bishop Coll has been visiting the 13 Pastoral Areas – parishes joined together to promote the life of the 'joined' parishes. We are joined in the St. Colmcille Pastoral Area with Inistioge. On 19th March the Bishop spoke with members of the Pastoral Councils and Finance Committees, emphasising the Church community as the People of God, a huge insight rising from the Second Vatican Council, 1962 – 1965. So, part of the People of God, we all, baptised, whether as laity, religious or priests, are called to active membership of the Church. This, joined with the scarcity of priests and religious, means that there is an urgency to 'put flesh on words'.
