Lent Begins: This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday the beginning of the season of Lent, during which time we prepare by prayer, fasting and almsgiving, to celebrate the kernel of our Christian Faith. We're mindful that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are still days of fast and abstinence – days when meat is not permitted. We may have one full meal as well as two other 'light' meals, or 'collations', according to each one's needs. Where health or ability to work may be seriously affected, this law does not apply.
